Vista Education Foundation and Vista Grange #609 Sign Agreements

Vista Education Foundation, a 501(3)c that raises funds for Vista Unified School District, and Vista Grange #609 have signed several agreements which give the VEF scholarship funds for perpetual scholarships in the areas of agriculture, animal sciences, nutrition or food science.

The first agreement in the amount of \$78,000 will go to seniors heading to college for a degree in the above referenced areas.

The second agreement in the amount of \$62,000 will go to seniors heading to academic or vocational training toward certification in the above referenced areas.

A third component of the agreements gives VEF \$12,500 to establish the VEF internship/apprenticeship program.

“These resources allow the VEF to increase our scholarship commitments. Additionally, we will establish a new component to our charter. The internship/apprenticeship program is under construction and this funding allows us to move forward,” stated Brad Peterson, President of the VEF. “I want to thank JoAnn Jones, VEF Board Member, and Hank Hitt, Vista Grange # 609 for all their efforts in completing this transaction.”
